

Thank you for your Business Our 2022-2023 Price Cap Program

Separate from our Pre-Buy Program, we are once again offering 2 plans of price protection as a way to express our appreciation for your patronage!

Choose one of these 2 Programs to cap your rate (without any fee) today!!

The Price Cap for the 2022/2023 Heating Season is *\$2.75/\$2.79 until May 31, 2023, provided the stated conditions (below) are met.

Keep Full “Net 30” Customer:

- The account must be setup as Keep Full and maintain a Current Status; we **must** receive your payment in the office within 30 days of delivery to be current.
- If we receive your payment in our office within 10 days of the delivery, you will receive a **\$.04 per gallon discount**, called the “cash” price.
- Your delivery price will be at the current market price or at the capped price, **whichever is lower**.
- If you’re a “Will Call” customer, you must switch to Keep Full before September 1, 2022 by submitting your request in writing or via email (existing Keep Full customers do not have to do anything except pay within 30 days of delivery).

Keep Full “Budget” Customer:

- You pay one **EASY** payment per month from July 2022 to May 2023 (June is the “settle up” month to pay the account balance; no payment is required if there’s no balance due). ---**Call 1-800-572-2191 for your monthly payment quote today!** ---
- Your payment is based upon previous propane usage. We monitor your usage and we’ll **advise you in advance** of any increase or reduction in the payment amount.
- We consider your account “current” and we’ll **deliver** at the discounted “cash” price if we receive your Budget Payment by the 10th of each month.
- We must receive your monthly Budget Payment **each month** to be eligible for the Keep Full market price or capped price, **whichever is lower** (unless we advise you not to pay anymore).

*As always, Customer owned tanks receive a \$.12 per gallon discount on the market and capped rates. When applicable, 120-gallon tanks will be charged \$.15 more (per gallon) than market and capped rates. At this time, C.O.D. customers are not eligible for Keep Full programs.
